Clinical Support Services Coordinator

Safe Connections is hiring for a Coordinator over Clinical Support Services. Clinical Support Services helps counseling clients of Safe Connections access individual and group counseling services at the agency. Tasks of the Coordinator include providing clients with intake, assessment and assisting with group counseling program development, marketing and coordination.

Additional duties include: providing short-term crisis counseling to clients on the waitlist, coordination of clinical internship activities, and cofacilitating counseling groups. The Clinical Support Services Coordinator will support program evaluation as well as participating in clinical case audit process and quality improvement activities. Position responsibilities will take place onsite at Safe Connections office and remotely.

Qualifications

Master's degree in Counseling, Social Work, Psychology or related field; Missouri LCSW or LPC licensure, experience providing culturally-sensitive therapy with clients on issues related to intimate partner and sexual violence, and trauma. Applied experience providing trauma-informed psychosocial assessment and group therapy. Experience with tele-behavioral health is beneficial.

A 37.5 hour work week with one evening required. Competitive salary and excellent benefits. 80% of medical insurance and all other insurance benefits are paid by Safe Connections.
