Part-Time Adolescent Therapist

Qualifications

Position requires a Master's degree in Social Work, Counseling, Psychology or equivalent. Current Missouri License required; LPC or LCSW preferred; Provisional license: PLPC or LMSW considered. Preferred qualities include: experience providing crisis intervention and counseling for teens impacted by violence, experience providing trauma therapy, experience leading groups, experience working in a school setting, experience developing group curricula, knowledge of community resources, cultural competency. Some evenings are required. Reliable transportation required.

Description

Safe Connections is seeking a Part-Time Adolescent Therapist, to provide individual and group therapy to adolescents affected by domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault and/or childhood sexual abuse. Services will be delivered in local high schools and middle schools, residential treatment facilities and at the Safe Connections office on Hampton.

Schedule will be determined at the start of hire. Competitive salary and excellent benefits.

Responsibilities

Direct Service Duties

- Provides direct services to adolescent clients through weekly therapy sessions.
- Screens callers and provides assessments for adolescents interested in individual therapy and support group services. Exercises judgment in assessing need for services, assessing suicide risk, completing safety planning, providing support and initiating referrals, as necessary.
- Completes documentation on individual therapy sessions within one week of session.
- Completes client service plans on a semi-annual basis, or more frequently as necessary.
- Completes all client evaluations.
- Collaborates with parents/guardians and other professionals, including psychiatrists, case workers, etc. on behalf of the client.
- Facilitates on and off-site psycho-educational support groups.
- Demonstrates awareness of socioeconomic and cultural diversity.

Administrative Duties

- Completes all agency statistical forms in a timely manner, provides statistical and descriptive data for development and administrative purposes.
- Participates on agency committees.
- Other duties as assigned.

Accountability

Accountable to the Adolescent Clinical Manager for carrying out assigned responsibilities and for following agency policies and procedures. Staff therapists are to provide services only within the scope of their training and experience.
